MALAMA KULA CRITERIA

- 1. The award need not be presented annually but only when the KCA Board of Directors so desires.
- 2. The award is to be presented to a single person or persons or to a single entity or group in recognition of a specific achievement(s).
- 3. It is preferred but not required that the recipient of the award reside in Kula and that the activity be of specific benefit to the Kula region.
- 4. The act(s) or contribution(s) being recognized should reflect the KCA purpose and/or vision statement.

The vision of the Kula Community Association is to preserve open space, support agriculture, maintain a rural residential atmosphere and to work together as a community.

The specific purpose of this association is to improve the quality of life for the residents of Kula, to promote civic welfare and generally to benefit the community of Kula.

- 5. The award may be presented posthumously.
- 6. It is preferred that there is unanimous agreement for the Malama Kula to be awarded. The Malama Kula will not be awarded if there is dissention.
