

## MALAMA KULA CRITERIA

1. The award need not be presented annually but only when the KCA Board of Directors so desires.
2. The award is to be presented to a single person or persons or to a single entity or group in recognition of a specific achievement(s).
3. It is preferred but not required that the recipient of the award reside in Kula and that the activity be of specific benefit to the Kula region.
4. The act(s) or contribution(s) being recognized should reflect the KCA purpose and/or vision statement.

*The vision of the Kula Community Association is to preserve open space, support agriculture, maintain a rural residential atmosphere and to work together as a community.*

*The specific purpose of this association is to improve the quality of life for the residents of Kula, to promote civic welfare and generally to benefit the community of Kula.*

5. The award may be presented posthumously.
6. It is preferred that there is unanimous agreement for the Malama Kula to be awarded. The Malama Kula will not be awarded if there is dissent.
