

NOTICE TO NEIGHBORING RESIDENTS
CONSTRUCTION OF KEOKEA-WAIOHULI DEVELOPMENT PHASE 1-A

The State of Hawaii Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) has entered into an agreement with Kiewit Infrastructure West Company (KIWC) to construct grading and drainage improvements in the Keokea – Waiohuli Subdivision. The purpose for this site construction is to provide grading and drainage improvements on 46 lots for future house construction to be offered to Waiohuli Undivided Interest lessees.

KIWC will begin mobilizing equipment and construction materials in April 2016 and the construction work is anticipated to be completed in April 2017.

Project limits extend from the Kauila'aha Street/ Keanuhea Street Intersection to Koapu'upu'u St / Olakino Place Intersection. A general project site map is attached. The majority of construction operations shall take place along Keanuhea Street and it is encouraged that residents plan to avoid utilizing this area during this period of construction.

The normal working hours will be from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM on weekdays except State of Hawaii Holidays.
